

Even bigger collection of Hanoverian horses in Alsfeld

3rd Alsfelder Advent in the Horse Centre in Hessen

Alsfeld. The Hannoveraner Verband will host its third „Alsfelder Advent“ in the Hessen Horse Centre in Alsfeld on December 2 and 3. Following the excellent feedback and the huge interest in 2009 and 2010, the collection was enlarged this year with now 48 horses put up for auction. The event will start on December 2 with a colourful show program, and be continued with the auction on Saturday, December 3, as of 3.00 pm.

The collection of the third „Alsfelder Advent“ features fascinating, first-class horses. When choosing the auction candidates aged three to seven, top priority was given to horses with all-round capabilities. Son of Hope is one of the most striking horses of the dressage collection. The four-year-old chestnut gelding by Sorento/Warkant (breeder: Pascale Wagemans, Einighausen/Netherlands) is an eye-catcher with his elastic and supple movement, and he can certainly best be described as most promising dressage prospect. Crazy Chicken is a few steps ahead as regards sports accomplishments. The seven-year-old expert for the course by Chico's Boy/Crazy Classic (breeder: Wilhelm Bollhorst, Wetschen) already won golden ribbons in jumper classes including M*-level with Guido Sperveslage.

The horses will be available for test riding in the Horse Centre in Alsfeld as of Thursday, November 22. The first presentation will be on Saturday, November 26, as of 9.00 am. Particularly chosen auction horses and show and sports presentations from Hessen will be shown at the Gala Evening Show on Friday, December 2, as of 8.00 pm. The riding and driving club Wackernheim will perform its prize-winning show act "Snow White's Transformation", presented during the show competition of all clubs at the Horse Show in the Frankfurt Festhalle in 2010. The Gestüt Tannenhof will present the four-year-old stallion Fahrenheit, and Ingo Jungblut's high jump performances will add that extra thrill. The unflappable nature of draught horses in exceptional situations and in a race against Shetland ponies will provide the necessary fun. A quadrille presentation with twelve Connemara ponies is an additional exciting part of the show evening.
