Approx. 100 Hanoverian Horses Put Up for Auction

Winter Auction opens the new year

Verden. The Winter Auction of Hanoverian riding horses will be held in the Niedersachsenhalle in Verden on January 29/30, 2010. Approx. 100 show jumping and dressage horses will be put up for auction. Training of the scopey young horses will start on January, 19.

The Verden selection committee has chosen 100 Hanoverian horses for ambitious competition and pleasure riders from among the approx. 500 horses presented during the selection trip in November. The constant price level at the Verden riding horse auctions enables customers from all over the world to find the suitable partner with best Hanoverian riding horse qualities for event, show jumping, dressage, driving, vaulting and hunting sport.

The collection of dressage horses features offspring of popular stallions like Londonderry, Hochadel, Rotspon and Don Crusador. Offspring of show jumping stallions like Contendro, Le Primeur, Escudo and Silvio, aged four to six, let the hearts of amateur and professional riders beat higher.

Photos and videos of the auction collection will be available on the Internet as of December 22. The horses will be presented in the Niedersachsenhalle on Sunday, January 24.
